Parking.

No trailers/Service Vehicles are permitted in the car park of Rally HQ the Longford Arms Hotel or at the front of the hotel on main street. The trailer Park is located at Cartronageeragh, Business Park Longford behind Tom McNally Motors Toyota Dealer on the N63 Athlone Road.

N 53 42.808, W 7 49.002 (All unoccupied Trailers shall be moved and not released until after the event should they be found to be causing a nuisance) This is a warning in the interest of public safety and orderly parking. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter. In the trailer park the onus is on the competitor to make secure their trailer for overnight parking as Midland Motor Club will not accept liability for loss or damage caused to property or equipment. There will be rolling security on Trailer Park from 8 p.m. on Saturday evening until 8.a.m. on Sunday morning only.

Recce.

Sign on for Recce will be in Rally HQ the Longford Arms Hotel Saturday 23th March from 08:15 to 11:30. Recce marshals will be on duty all day. You are permitted to Recce Saturday 23rd March after Recce sign on between the hours 8:30 and 17:00. Pace notes will be available for sale from Third Parties. The Club has no involvement with their preparation or sale and accepts no responsibility for their accuracy or otherwise.

Competitors will be allowed make pace notes on Saturday 23rd March 2019 between 08.30 and 17.00. Recce stickers must be displayed on the top corner of the windscreen of the recce car. A maximum of three runs per stage is permitted. The road will be open to normal traffic, therefore the safety and rights of other road users must be respected. Please respect the residents on all the stage routes and road sections. It is with their good will that this Rally can take place. Please obey the rules of the road including road speed limits and any speed limit imposed on the stages by Midland Motor Club during ecce. An Garda Síochána will be active on both Recce day and Rally day. **STRICTLY NO SPEEDING ON RECCE. PENALTY OF EXCLUSION WILL APPLY.**

All Licences and IRDS/NES (Drivers Only) letters must be produced at paper scrutiny. Any crew not signed on for recce will be deemed as non starters.

Mechanical Scrutiny.

Please present your car for Mechanical Scrutiny at Mastertech Business Part Athlone Road Longford.

N 53 43.307, W 7 48.508 - Scrutiny will be open 14:00 to 19:30. Your car must be placed in Parc Ferme immediately after it passes Mechanical Scrutiny. Please obey the Marshals at Scrutiny, no trailers will be allowed past the unloading area.

Paper Scrutiny.

Rally Office opens again at 14:00. You will have 30 mins to attend Paper Scrutiny in the Longford Arms Hotel **N 53 43.735, W 7 48.085** once you have finished Mechanical Scrutiny. Paper Scrutiny closes at 20:00.

Parc Ferme.

Parc Ferme is located in the Old Army Barracks, approximately 200M from HQ on Bridge Street, Longford Town. No Vans or trailers permitted in Parc Ferme for loading or unloading after the event.

N 53 43.842, W 7 48.132 There will be security on Parc Ferme all night.

Service Area.

Service Area shall be open on Sunday March 24th at 07:15. Service Area is located in Mastertech Business park Athlone Road Longford **N 53 43.307, W 7 48**. We are grateful to the Quinn Family and all the business in this park for permission to use this area. Please obey Service manager and marshals.

All Competition Cars must use a large non porous Service Mat when in the Service area. Penalty for not using a mat or littering the service area: 2 minutes. Appendix 29 ARTICLE 9.1 Strictly No Parking on the Main Road outside service. Please dispose of all rubbish in service using the bin bags provided in your pack. We request that competitors and service crews respect this property and keep their service area tidy. Local Authority Litter Warden will be in attendance and penalties will be applied to crews who leave rubbish.

- Smoking is Forbidden in the Service Area.
- Service Barges must be equipped with the following
 - 1 X 6KG ABC Dry Powder Fire Extinguisher (for each car serviced)
 - 1 X 6 litre AFFFF (Foam Fire Extinguisher (for each car serviced)
- Extinguishers must be placed in a visible area, and have ease of access too
- Fire Extinguisher Board to be in place over extinguishers
- Hot work is only undertaken by competent persons.

The service area manager will undertake checks on no smoking policy, signage and extinguishers

Ground sheets are compulsory for service and must be used at all times.

Competitors Safety - Safety Tracking System

All cars must be fitted with the Safety Tracking System (STS) device provided by the STS provider (Sporttraxx) during reconnaissance and competition. The STS devices will be distributed during reconnaissance sign-on with the **road book**. Competitor competition licences will be held by way of deposit on the device, returnable upon timely and undamaged return of the device. All crews must declare the number of the mobile phone which they will carry with them on board and maintain in the 'ON' state during the entire event.

The crew are personally responsible for installing the STS device in their reconnaissance car. During reconnaissance the STS device must be in a visible place, so Marshals or other Officials will be able to identify it. The STS device will be collected following reconnaissance at documentation scrutineering and will be recharged overnight. The device will be fitted to competition cars by Sporttraxx personnel before the Parc Ferme Out Control on the morning of competition.

The STS device will be collected at the Parc Ferme In Control (Final Control) by Sporttraxx personnel. In the event of retirement, the STS device must be returned to Sporttraxx personnel in the event Service Area or at the Parc Ferme In Control (contact phone number will be provided).

Drivers Briefing.

Drivers briefing will take place in Rally HQ the Ballroom 08:10. A random roll call of 10 crews may be made. First Car away from Parc Ferme at 09.10.
